### Minutes of Regular Meeting on March 9, 2020

**Call to Order:** Having established a quorum, Chairman Callard called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**Approval of Minutes:** Commissioner Loesch made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on February 10, 2020, seconded by Commissioner Walter. With no further discussion, a vote was taken. All in favor; motion carried.

#### Unfinished Business

**Fire:** Deputy Chief Moxley provided the following update:

Candidate Christian Moreno failed the background investigation and has been notified that he is no longer being considered for a position with the Rolling Meadows Fire Department.

Candidates James Purrazzo and Samantha Hiller each took a one time pass, and we are currently awaiting their signed confirmation.

Candidate Samuel Garcia did not wish to continue in the process and will remain with his current employer.

Candidate Brennen Legan has not responded to Deputy Chief Moxley's attempts to contact him by telephone for two weeks. Deputy Chief Moxley will attempt to contact Mr. Legan via e-mail today.

**Police:** Chief Nowacki provided an update on the upcoming Sergeants testing: IO Solutions is expected to send the questions for the written exam for Chief Nowacki's consideration. The test is scheduled to take place on April 2 in the EOC from 9 to noon.

### **New Business**

**Fire:** Deputy Chief Moxley informed the Commissioners that the new fire station on Hicks Road will be open and operational in April 2020.

**Police:** Chief Nowacki reminded the Commissioners that the Police entry level eligibility list will expire on November 11, 2020, and consideration should be given to selecting a date for the next exam. While a tentative date in September was discussed, additional consideration of a date will be discussed at a future meeting.
