

RESOLUTION NO. 24-R-51

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO SHORTLIST ENGINEERING FIRMS
FOR VARIOUS UTILITIES AS DEFINED BY THE REQUEST
FOR QUALIFICATION (RFQ)**

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows ("City") maintains the City's public potable water, sanitary sewer, and stormwater utilities; and

WHEREAS, the City has posted a request for qualifications for various utilities to be able to complete future engineering projects and programs; and

WHEREAS, the City had its representatives select the top two or three firms depending on submissions for each utility based on a qualifications rating system and averaged out the scores to ultimately select the top three firms per utility; and

WHEREAS, the City will enter into a contract with each engineering firm to ensure the safety of our City with all the engineering firms for upcoming design, work, and observation; and

WHEREAS, the City is mandated by the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District (MWRD) and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) to perform various programs and projects to enhance and safeguard the City's infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, Ciorba Group, Baxter & Woodman, and HLR were the top three rated water utility engineering firms; and

WHEREAS, Christopher B. Burke Engineering, LTD., Strand Associates, and WBK Engineering were the top rated storm utility engineering firms; and

WHEREAS, RJN Group, and Thomas Engineering Group were the top two rated sanitary utility engineering firms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby approve the Water, Sanitary, and Storm Water Engineering Shortlists.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


