

RESOLUTION NO. 25-R-13

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2025 FORD UTILITY INTERCEPTOR HYBRID (REPLACEMENT OF RM411/C187) FROM CURRIE MOTORS IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$52,594.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows ("City") maintains the city's vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to replace equipment at recommended time intervals in accordance with the City's Vehicle Replacement Policy; and

WHEREAS, the City has a long-term capital program that includes replacing vehicles and equipment per the Vehicle Replacement Policy; and

WHEREAS, Currie Motors has provided a quote to the City for a total cost of \$52,594.00 utilizing the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative Contract #204; and

WHEREAS, Ford has made a limited amount of Hybrid Utility Interceptors available for purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City will seek out proposals from specialized vendors for the purchase and installation of all lighting and equipment at a later date, and

WHEREAS, the 2025 FY Budget provides funding in an amount of \$65,000 from account 25305020-60032 for a police patrol vehicle in the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with Currie Motors for the purchase of one (1) police patrol vehicle in a not to exceed amount of \$52,594.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.
