City-based Business License Renewals Due Wednesday, December 31st

The Community Development Department will soon send 2026 business license renewal applications to all Rolling Meadows-based businesses. Payments must be received by Wednesday, December 31st.

Renewal applications and payments postmarked or submitted after the 12/31 deadline will be considered past due and be assessed a late fee that doubles the cost of the annual license. Fees are based, in part, on business type and square footage of applicants' premises. Additional registration and inspection fees may apply.
