

RESOLUTION NO. 26-R-17

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF A HP LATEX 730 64" WIDE FORMAT PRINTER FROM IT SUPPLIES FOR TRAFFIC SIGN SHOP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,368.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows ("City") is responsible for ensuring safe travel on all City roadways and properly manufactured and clearly visible traffic signs are an essential component of maintaining that safety; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the new printer will enhance production capabilities to meet the City's updated branding needs and improve print quality for signage and other graphic applications; and

WHEREAS, the upgraded equipment will reduce the City's reliance on outside vendors for event banners and other large-format materials, resulting in additional cost savings and faster turnaround times; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund 25705025-60036 maintains sufficient reserves for the purchase of sign equipment due to project deferrals and realized cost savings; and

WHEREAS, the recommended vendor, IT Supplies, is a local Rolling Meadows business, providing local support and contributing to the community's economic vitality; and

WHEREAS, the City has been supplied with 3 quotes, IT Supplies, Grimco, Inc and Lexjet; and

WHEREAS, IT Supplies provided the lowest responsible quote of \$25,368.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with IT Supplies to Authorize the Purchase of an HP Latex 730 Wide Format Printer from IT Supplies in the Amount of \$25,368.00.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with IT Supplies, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).


Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


