

Ordinance No. 11-15

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-13

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance Number 10-13 on May 18, 2010, which Ordinance found two (2) police department motorcycles to be surplus property and further provided for the motorcycles to be sold; and

WHEREAS, the City has not been able to sell the motorcycles pursuant to the terms of Ordinance Number 10-13; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now finds that the motorcycles may be useful to the police department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois as follows:

Section One: The City's Ordinance Number 10-13 is hereby repealed.

Section Two: The following described personal property shall remain as part of the City's inventory of vehicles and shall not be sold by the City until such time as the City Council may otherwise provide by Ordinance:

Section Three: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.






