

### **Public Act (PA) 97-0609 Compliance**

On August 26, 2011, Gov. Pat Quinn signed Senate Bill 1831 (Public Act 97-0609). This law makes several changes to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) statute and amends the Open Meetings Act.

PA 97-0609 requires that an employer participating in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) is required to make available a list of all employees that are expected to receive compensation greater than \$75,000. This list must be available six business days after a budget is approved.

Compensation includes salary/wages, clothing allowance, vehicle allowance (none for the City of Rolling Meadows), health insurance, bonuses (none for the City of Rolling Meadows), loans (none for the City of Rolling Meadows), vacation days granted (based on the number of hours worked per day because not all employees work an 8 hour day), and sick days granted (based on the number of hours worked per day because not all employees work an 8 hour day).

The City of Rolling Meadows went one step further, to enhance transparency, and is publishing this data for all employees.
