

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PERMIT TO INSTALL A LAWN SPRINKLER SYSTEM

Overview

This information is designed to assist an applicant in applying for a permit for a lawn sprinkler system that will meet the codes of the City of Rolling Meadows. Some lawn sprinkler systems may involve more than the information contained herein is intended to cover.

Specific Application Requirements:

Submit three (3) site plans using a plat of survey showing:

- Location of sprinkler heads
- Location of sprinkler heads in parkway (right of way), *if applicable*
- Location of RPZ (reduced pressure zone valve)

Submit Required Applications and Licenses:

- Plumbing application must be signed by contractor.

Submit Waiver to Install Lawn Sprinkler System:

- If the sprinkler system is to be placed in the public right of way (parkway) there is an agreement with the City that must be signed by titleholders of the property. This agreement must be signed and notarized by all titleholders of the property.

Inspections Requirements:

Final inspection is required after a system is installed. The RPZ valve is required to be tested and certified by a Cross-Connection Control Device Inspector, upon installation and annually thereafter. **Written certification of the RPZ shall be provided at time of final inspection.**
